

DSGN 262 Video Production II

This course will allow students to develop professional skills in video, film, and television preproduction, production, and post-production. Advance of video production, including the techniques and the aesthetics of shooting, lighting, and editing will be covered.

(Pre-requisites: DSGN 261)

- 6. To obtain post-production and video editing skills.
- 7. To obtain the ability to, independently and in groups, work through complex video production projects in complex environments.
