

DSGN 402 Capstone II

This course emphasizes the production of the project researched and proposed in DSGN 401 and allows the student to demonstrate the practical skills and academic studies accumulated during the degree program. Emphasis is on meeting deadlines and on eliminating challenges determined by the project committee. Solutions to obstacles are suggested accordingly. (*Pre-requisites: DSGN 401*)
